

Can cables be connected inside a cable tray

Per NEC Article 392 and Article 336, tray cables can run openly in listed cable trays, well supported and protected from excessive damage. Cable trays allow easy access for maintenance, which is one of ...

Using it for anything other than its intended purpose violates NEC 392.18 (H) and can overload the tray structure, damaging both the tray and the cables inside it.

Cable tray installed in a hazardous location must contain only those cables that are appropriate for this type of environment as defined in Chapter 5 of the NEC.
