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This process, called "jointing," may be needed to create a longer busbar from shorter, more manageable pieces; or to create a T-shaped tap-off connection from the main busbar.

Shaped busbars may be prefabricated by using friction stir welding. 1. Bolted joints (most common) Bolted joints are formed by overlapping the bars and bolting through the overlap area.
