One of our clients recently had their electric meter replaced by their utility company - a seemingly normal upgrade that they had thought nothing of at the time.

Just be sure the bills are based on actual, not estimated, meter readings, and be aware of when the meter was read, because the time period between readings can vary.

Most meter problems are the result of vandalism, tampering or an accident. If the protective glass cover or the seals on the meter are broken, it may not operate properly.

If the reading differs the wattage rating of your device by a minimum of 5%, your meter is over-reading. In such a case, you must get your electric meter tested by a professional immediately.

Using a multimeter set to AC current, the reading should be significantly lower than the maximum rating. A current reading exceeding the maximum amperage suggests a potential ...
