A Schengen Transit Visa (or Airport Transit Visa) is required for certain travelers who pass through a Schengen country, such as Spain, while en route to a non-Schengen destination.

A Spain Schengen Airport Transit Visa is required for travelers from specific countries transiting through Spanish airports without entering Spain or the Schengen area.
