

The router s fiber optic cable cannot be unplugged

Check the green fibre optic cable is connected to the ONT properly. Be very careful handling the cable as the fibre is delicate and can be damaged if not handled carefully.

This is one of the most difficult fiber connectors due to it being single mode fiber with an 8.3um core. Also the connector requires an 8 degree polish to reduce back reflection to the equipment.
