neutral adjective (NOT NOTICEABLE) C1 having features or characteristics that are not easily noticed:

The ground mat at the substation serving as a source for the distribution circuit is one of the paths for neutral current to return to the transformer neutral connection.

Neutral wires are typically "bonded" to Earth (ground) at either the electrical service entrance, or at transformers within the system. An exception to this is found in the IT earthing arrangement.

In absence of a ground fault, the neutral of an ungrounded system under reasonably balanced load conditions will usually be held there by the balanced electrostatic capacitance between each phase ...
